Charge Value: may be null; must define a Period of Recharge; must have Period of Recharge equal or less than One Year; and may be different for Binary Access or for Binary Access with Source Code Access. An earlier Recharge, i.e., a Recharge during a Period of Charge or Recharge: cannot be required; is optional; is overwriting (Resets Charging Period); it not cumulative (does not reset charge period from its end). If both Binary and Source Code Access has the same value, Binary Access with Source Code Access is implied. Whether to Offer or not Binary Access, whether or not to Offer Source Code Access and the variables in Charging and Access Policies per Item is deliberated by the Owner and maybe different at any time and to any entity. Within Charge or Recharge period, ca2 is responsible for supplying Binary and Source Code Access respecting informed Policies. The Owner should use ca2 API to grant User Access (always by summing up access) and process Payments through third-party payment systems. The Owner should be able to configure for each of its Owned Items, whether none, selectively chosen or all ca2 gateways (stores) should License the Item according to Offer, Charging and Access Policies that can be stored in ca2 through ca2 API and to the running degree of configuration customization and granularity offered by the gateways.
